POSITION: Casual Intake Clinician - Mobile Crisis Team - Youth Crisis Stabilization System

SUMMARY: Macdonald Youth Services requires casual Intake Clinicians to provide telephone crisis intervention and triage functions for the Mobile Crisis Team. These positions assess the nature and extent of the crisis situation and determine appropriate response.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES: Include, but are not limited to, answering the telephone lines and responding accordingly to the needs of callers; be aware of all community resources and their services offered, the target population and how referrals are processed; gather relevant information on calls, determine appropriateness for Mobile Crisis Team response, be able to prioritize requests and know the whereabouts of the Mobile Crisis Teams at all times when on shift. Prioritize the order in which the Mobile Crisis Team responds to requests for service.

ESSENTIAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Undergraduate degree in Human Services;
- Knowledge of child and adolescent development;
- Valid driver's license;
- Excellent verbal skills.

PREFERRED REQUIREMENTS:

- Knowledge of child welfare act;
- Knowledge of child and adolescent mental health issues and resources;
- Current First Aid/CPR, Suicide Intervention & NVCI certification;
- Knowledge of Aboriginal language and culture.

SALARY RANGE: \$19.26 - \$21.87 per hour.
