The Outreach Worker will be responsible to provide one-on-one support and mentorship for Touchstone's Program Participants who are youth and adults living with FASD.

This position will provide valuable knowledge and expertise for those interested in pursuing careers in education, justice or social work.

Required Skills:

- Excellent communication skills, both interpersonal and written.
- Good driving record.
- Critical thinking and creative problem solving abilities.
- Ability to be self-motivated.
- Ability to make independent decisions within general framework of program policies
- Ability to set safe and appropriate boundaries.
- Ability to work as a team member.
- Ability to handle job stress.
- Ability to work alongside imperfect systems within an imperfect society.
- Ability to exercise patience and flexibility.

Assets:

- Experience working in Social Services field.
- Education in Social Services or relevant field.
- Knowledge and understanding of the issues and challenges associated with FASD.

The majority of outreach shifts are 5 – 8 hour weekday shifts. The ability to work weekends may be an asset. Pay scale starting between \$12 - \$16 per hour depending on experience and qualifications.
