This Casual Treatment role is responsible for the supervision and safety of youth in the home; accomplished through daily interaction, care and implementation of treatment plans.

Availability: Days, Evenings, Overnight, and Weekends

SKILLS AND ABILITIES...

- Child and Youth Care Certificate or post-secondary education in a related field
- An understanding of aboriginal culture and issues facing youth at risk
- Strong communication skills with experience in written documentation
- Ability to work independently with strong problem solving abilities
- Excellent interpersonal skills and the ability to relate to youth
- Experience in working with youth and an understanding of treatment models
- Current First Aid/CPR Certificate
- Current Criminal Record, clear Child Abuse Registry and Prior Contact Checks
- Non-Violent Crisis Intervention Certificate is an asset

DUTIES INCLUDE...

- Provide care, support and supervision to the youth as part of the treatment team
- Assist in the ongoing implementation of individual treatment plans
- Carry out and document regular room and house checks ensuring all safety standards are met
- Create a positive, therapeutic and structured environment that encourages the wellbeing of the youth within the home
- Involve youth in household tasks such as chore participation, meal preparation and menu planning
- Provide a shift change report to staff
- Carry out appropriate record keeping functions as required by licensing standards and B&L policies and procedures
